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## **PARCO DEL MARE**

The most beautiful seafront in the world—perfect to explore on foot or by bike, or for a bit of sport, with dedicated Technogym-equipped areas.

Ideal for an early morning walk or a sunset ride.

## **THE RIMINI PIER**

A walk all the way to the end, where the sea speaks louder. Here, iodine feels like an embrace, the sound of the waves becomes a mantra, and every sunset is a perfect ending.

## **DARSENA & 150 KM OF CYCLE PATHS**

A pier that moves above and below the sea, telling stories of the harbor, the boats and the dawn.

From here begins a network of 150 km of cycling paths: from the sea to the city centre, and from the city to the hills.

## **THE BEACHES OF THE RIVIERA**

Places where Romagna's hospitality becomes an art.

From colourful beach cabins to beloved kiosks, from the first swim in the morning to a refreshing drink while watching the sunset.

## **LA PIAZZA SULL'ACQUA - PONTE DI TIBERIO**

The most magical part of the city, suspended between two thousand years of history and water reflecting the sky.

A place made for sitting on a bench and letting your thoughts wander. Right next to Piazza sull'Acqua lies Parco XXV Aprile, the city's largest green area. From here, several cycling routes wind through nature towards the charming villages of the Rimini hinterland.

## **BORGO SAN GIULIANO**

The fishermen's district that Fellini turned into poetry.

Low houses, vibrant colours, murals appearing around corners like memories. Connected to the city centre by the ancient Tiberius Bridge, it is now one of the coolest areas in Rimini. Once home to fishermen's families, today it is full of artisan shops, wine bars and traditional restaurants.


## **IL LUNGOFIUME DEGLI ARTISTI**

An open-air art gallery that tells the story of Rimini in an authentic way. Easily reachable by bike, it is part of a network of scenic cycling routes.

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## **ROMAN RIMINI**

**Castel Sismondo, the Arch of Augustus, Tiberius Bridge, the Surgeon's House.**

The medieval castle designed by the Malatesta family holds stories of power and mystery. Around it, **Roman Rimini reveals itself through the Surgeon's House**, the amphitheatre and the ancient city walls that still watch over the historic centre.

## **TIBERIUS BRIDGE**
